

Guidelines for Return to School After Fever/Illness
August 2021

In accordance with the CDC and the Polk County Health Center, these are our current guidelines for return to school after fever/illness:

- 24 (FULL) hours fever free (without fever reducing medicine) AND with a negative COVID test result & note from a health care provider.
- 24 (FULL) hours fever free (without fever reducing medicine) AND with a note from medical provider indicating student may return to school and why COVID testing was not done and/or diagnosis.
- If student/guardian chooses not to be seen by a health care provider, student may be quarantined away from school for 14 days AND be 24 hours fever free (without fever reducing medicine).
- If student has a positive COVID test, it must be 10 days from onset of symptoms or positive test and be fever free for 24 hours and all symptoms must have improved for student to return to school.
